

**Applying College Credit for Themes in Perspectives for Transfer Students During the  
Academic Year 2009 -2010 ONLY**

<b>Transfers from a NC Community College who have completed 44 hour CAA, AA, AS degrees</b>	
Not subject to themes in Perspectives requirements.	
<b>For those transfer student who are not completers or graduates, follow these guidelines</b>	
Transfer student has more than one course in any of the Perspectives, but they are in different themes	Transfer student may choose one additional course from either of the themes where the courses appear and count the group of 3 courses as their 9 hour theme.
Transfer student has one course in a theme in a Perspective	Transfer student must complete the theme where the course resides, or start over in a new theme and take at least 6 hours. The transfer course then becomes an elective (or could count in the major/minor).  Transfer student should follow the transfer credit articulation process.
Transfer student has a course that is listed in two themes in the same Perspective (i.e PSY 1200 in "Individual and Society" and in "Mind") (both in Historical and Social)	Transfer student must choose one of those themes to complete, or start over in a new theme and complete at least 6 hours. The transfer course then becomes an elective. (Or could count in the major/minor).  Transfer student should follow the transfer credit articulation process.
Transfer student has transfer courses that could count in themes, but does not want to complete those themes	Transfer student starts in a new theme and the transfer courses are electives or could count in the major/minor.  Transfer student should follow the transfer credit articulation process.

**Awarding credit for Historical Studies, Literary Studies, and Fine Arts designations will be by course and therefore, may be met during this year of transition (2009 – 2010) without reference to themes.**
