

Guidelines

A student who has earned an associate's degree from an accredited institution outside the North Carolina Community College System may request for the Office of General Education to review his or her coursework for possible completion of Appalachian's General Education program. The student should contact the Office by phone at (828) 262-2028 or email at gened@appstate.edu to initiate this review.

The student's official transcript should show the date the associate's degree was awarded. Completion of the following coursework, with a grade of C or better in each course, will fulfill the requirements of Appalachian's General Education program.

44 semester hours in general education courses, including the following specific areas:

8 hours (2 courses, with labs) in Natural Science; courses must not be major-specific

3 hours in Math

3 hours in Math, Computer Information Systems, or Statistics

6 hours in English Composition

12 hours of Humanities/Fine Arts in at least 3 disciplines; 3 hours must be Literature

12 hours of Social/Behavioral Sciences in at least 3 disciplines; 3 hours must be History
