Re: U.S History Survey equivalents

The articulation agreement for fall 2009-2010 shows that transfer credit for either half of the U.S. History survey will now be His 1200 rather than His 2201 or His 2204, as was done previously. If a student comes in with both halves of the U.S. survey, they will be receiving His 1200 and 3 hours His credit.

Please keep in mind that His 1200 will not count for the History major. His 1200 credit will not count as 2201 or 2204 unless an official substitution is requested (see below). For those students who will be either History Majors or secondary ed history majors consider the following options.

*If you have a student who comes in with credit for 1200 and is planning to be a history major, please consider making a substitution for 1200 with either 2201 (if they have taken the 1st half of U.S. history) or 2204 if they have taken the 2nd half).

•If they have come in with both halves of the survey and plan to be a history major or secondary ed history major, consider substituting 1200 with 2201 and the 3 hours history credit as 2204.
