Program Priorities for 2011 - 2012

The General Education leadership team has identified the following goals for the current academic year:

First Year Seminar

1. Increase participation of T/TT faculty in FYS
2. Develop a cohesive, multi-level faculty development program for FYS
3. Revise the FYS student course evaluation form and process
4. Codify a process for FYS course renewal

Perspectives Themes and other Components of the Curriculum

1. Identify ways to communicate integration expectations more clearly to faculty teaching in the Perspectives
2. Sponsor a new series of events related to the Perspectives themes
3. Codify the renewal process for General Education courses and themes and communicate the process to the campus
4. Provide faculty with tools and strategies for communicating with students about the General Education Program

Transfer Students

1. Design and implement new transfer policies for FYS
2. Continue identifying courses from other institutions to add to the transfer articulation tables
3. Codify criteria for evaluating completion of the General Education Program via an out-of-state AA/AS degree or completion of general education requirements at another 4-year institution

Assessment

1. Further develop a comprehensive assessment plan and communicate it to the campus
2. Increase faculty participation in assessment

Communication

1. Enhance communication with General Education faculty about events and opportunities available on campus related to their courses
2. Identify strategies for improving communication with incoming and current Gen Ed students about the Program
3. Produce a monthly newsletter for faculty with information about what is going on in all aspects of the Program
