- 1) Will all courses currently approved for the Gen Ed and which want to be in the new Gen Ed be automatically included in the new Liberal Studies Experience portion of the revised Gen Ed (or will each course have to reapply)?
- 2) Will all themes currently approved for the Gen Ed and which want to be in the new Gen Ed be automatically included in the new Appalachian Integrative Learning Experience portion of the revised Gen Ed (or will each theme have to reapply)?
- 3) Will all courses that are in an approved theme in the Appalachian Integrative Learning Experience portion of the revised Gen Ed automatically also be considered as a "stand alone" course in the Liberal Studies Experience portion of the revised Gen Ed? (If so the student would NOT be able to have it count toward the theme in the Appalachian Integrative Learning Experience AND ALSO as a course in the Liberal Studies Experience portion, but only as one of the 12 hours of the latter.)
- 4) How will the students who are in the current Gen Ed program compete their Gen Ed requirements when the revised program is in place? Are there still students fulfilling the old Core Curriculum and if so how will these students complete their Core Curriculum/Gen Ed requirements?
- 6) For any new applications (for themes or courses) who will decide on the criteria for inclusion in the Gen Ed and when will these guidelines be available?
