Students re-enrolling for Fall 2009 may select a catalog from the 2003-2004 academic year or later, as long as the student was enrolled during that year. Students who choose to follow the degree requirements of the 2009-2010 catalog year will have their Core Curriculum credited as a block toward meeting General Education requirements. They must complete WID and CAP in the major to complete General Education.</p>
<p>Students who were ASU students (not graduates) returning to complete degree but did not complete the core curriculum</p>	<p>Students may choose to follow the degree requirements listed in the catalog effective the year they first registered for classes at Appalachian, or any subsequent catalog year in which they were enrolled, as long as the catalog chosen is six years old or less. Students re-enrolling for Fall 2009 may select a catalog from the 2003-2004 academic year or later, as long as the student was enrolled during that year. Students who choose to follow the degree requirements of the 2009-2010 catalog year will have their courses articulated to the new General Education program as with transfer students and will need to complete any missing components. These students will complete themes in perspectives just as transfers do.</p>

<p>Students currently enrolled at ASU who started prior to 094 but want to change to a new major or updated major or minor curriculum that takes effect fall 2009 (or later) and will finish within six years of a catalog requiring core (core not completed)</p>	<p>Core courses articulated to general education as with transfers. Complete missing components. Completion of themes in Perspectives required as for transfers.</p>
<p>Students currently enrolled at ASU who wish to repeat a course which is no longer offered because a department updated its course offerings.</p>	<p>If the department has identified an equivalent course currently offered, students may use the equivalent course as an acceptable option for repeating a course. (i.e. ENG 2001 may count as a repeat for ENG 1100). The Registrar’s Office is working on the specific process to follow to ensure proper coding on student records. Additional courses will be added to this list as they are identified by the department.</p> <p><u>Course Equivalents Identified by Departments</u> ENG 2001 may count as a repeat for ENG 1100. HIS 1110, 1120, 1130, 1600, or 2312 may count as a repeat for HIS 1101. HIS 1110, 1120, 1130, 1200, 1400, 1501, or 1600 may count as a repeat for HIS 1102. HIS 1110, 1120, or 1130 may count as a repeat for HIS 1103. HIS 1120, 1600, or 2312 may count as a repeat for HIS 1510.
